Hello Central Families,

We hope you all had a restful summer! We are excited to see all our students as we start a new school year. We understand that some families and students may be anxious about coming back. Please remember that we continue to have our students' best interest at heart. We are confident that we can restart safely. We apologize in advance for the lengthy letter as we have many items to share with you.

## First Day Procedures:

School will begin for grade 1-grade 6 on **Tuesday, September 7, 2021** with a partial day from **8:42 am to 10:55 am only.** 

Once the bell rings, we will have all the students line up outside by cones labelled with their grade. The classroom teachers will call out their students and then escort them into the school. Staff will circulate outside to assist students in this process. Dismissal on the first day will be at 10:55 am. Supervision will be provided for all bus students until their bus arrives to pick them up at the end of the day.

**Wednesday, September 8, 2021** will be a full day for students grade 1-6. Students will be expected to line up by the cone with their teacher's name once the bell rings. Their teacher will escort them into the school.

Please remember to pack a lunch, a water bottle and inside shoes. We encourage all families to label their child's belongings with a permanent marker to help them keep track of their shoes, lunch bag, etc.

**Kindergarten:** Kindergarten students will be on a gradual entry. The kindergarten teachers will be meeting all families either on Wednesday, September 8 or Thursday, September 9, 2021. Please let us know if you have not received the schedule.

Tissue and Treats: Our PAC will be providing tissue and treats for our K parents on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 by the bus stop. This is a wonderful opportunity for our K parents to meet each other.

**PAC:** The first PAC meeting will be Thursday, September 16th, 2021 at 6:30 via Zoom. More information to come.

**Mask:** Masks are not required for K-3 students but can be worn. Students in grades 4-6 and all staff must wear a mask


#### Fee Schedule
