Hello Central Families,

We hope you all had a restful summer! We would like to welcome all our new families and our returning families.

First Day Procedures:

School will begin for grade 1-grade 6 on **Tuesday, September 6, 2022** with a partial day from **8:45 am to 10:52 am only.**

Once the bell rings, we will have all the students line up outside by cones labelled with their grade. The classroom teachers will call out their students and then escort them into the school. Staff will circulate outside to assist students in this process. Dismissal on the first day will be at 10:52 am. Supervision will be provided for all bus students until their bus arrives to pick them up at the end of the day.

Wednesday, September 7, 2022 will be a full day for students grade 1-6. Students will be expected to line up by the cone with their teacher's name once the bell rings. Their teacher will escort them into the school.

Please remember to pack a lunch, a water bottle and inside shoes. We encourage all families to label their child's belongings with a permanent marker to help them keep track of their shoes, lunch bag, etc.

Kindergarten: Kindergarten students will be on a gradual entry schedule. The kindergarten teachers will be meeting all families on Wednesday, September 7, 2022 at 9:30 am (Last name A-L) or 1:00 pm (Last name M-Z). Please let us know if you have not received the schedule.

Tissue and Treats: Our PAC will be providing tissue and treats for our K parents on Wednesday, September 14, 2022 in our common space at 8:45 am to 10:00 am. This is a wonderful opportunity for our K parents to meet each other.

PAC: The first PAC meeting will be Thursday, September 15th, 2022 at 6:30 in the common space. Please consider joining us if you want your voice to be heard regarding decisions made and voted on by the PAC.

Adult/Parent entry into the school must be done at the main entrance doors only. For our students safety, we need to know who is in our school.

Fees:

School Supplies: As mentioned on the previous newsletter, we have purchased school supplies for families at a cost of \$40.00/child for primary and \$45.00/child for intermediate students. This alleviates families from having to search out lists and supplies. We buy our supplies in bulk and as a result we get great prices, which we pass along to our families. It also ensures that students receive the supplies that their specific teacher wants to use. We ask that all parents try to have the fees paid by October 14th, 2022.
